FINN WINS SKI JUMP.

The day was perfect for the international Ski Meeting at Garmisch Partenkirchen, Bavaria. And despite the absence of many amateur stars at the Winter Olympics there was a lot of magnificent jumping.

There were also a few spills, most of them not so bad as they looked.

Garmisch can make out a good claim that this is the best ski-jump in the world. It still bears the Olympic symbol, a reminder that the Winter Games were held here, in 1936.

Antti Nyman, the Finnish veteran who was an Olympic winner four years ago, was in his best form.

So the star from Finland was the winner, with a jump of 264 feet.
