

OLYMPIC STARS SET RECORDS.

Pointer to the Olympic Games was the Women's 220-yards Free Style event in the Australian Championships, at North Sydney pool. Dawn Frazer was in the lead at the first turn, but only a shade in front of her big rival Ilse Konrads. In Olympic Trials Dawn has already beaten three world records.

It was Dawn Frazer first, beating her own world record, and just behind was Ilse Konrads. In those two girls, Australia will have formidable representatives in Rome.

Line-up for the men's 16-hundred-and-fifty yards. Among them Jon Konrads, Ilse's 18-year-old brother. They were born in Latvia, came to Australia eleven years ago.

Powerfully turning into the second length Jon Konrads set a hot pace. Spectators guessed he'd keep it up for another 28 lengths till the end.
