

CARDIFF VS. BANGOR.

Graham Moore kicked off for Cardiff City against Bangor City, on the Racecourse at Wrexham in the Semi-Final of the Welsh Cup. Cardiff won the trophy last year, and Bangor reached the semi-final. Within two minutes of Cardiff's goal Bangor drew level. Outside right Hunt hit the post; Betts banged it home.

There was no more scoring. The game was a one-one draw.
