BRAHAM WINS AGAIN.

21 star drivers roared off in Heat One of the Brussels Grand Prix. It's rare for anything to go wrong so early, but a triple crash came here, Flockhart, Gendebien and Brooks colliding. Not much interest left in the race for them.

Stirling Moss led. Driving a Porsche (a German car) he was too fast for the rest. Nearest rival, World Champion Jack Brabham, in a Cooper. And fifty-one seconds ahead of him, Moss won the heat.

During the 2nd heat it was raining, with Brabham now faster than Moss, who couldn't corner so well. Challenging both was the French ace, Trintignant.

Moss went pretty well till he had gearbox trouble; then with the best time for both heats the winner was once again, Jack Brabham. Australian driver, British car.
