RED CHINA'S PREMIER IN BURMA

Burma's Premier U Nu and other leaders greet Red China's Premier Chou En-Lai, who reaches Rangoon in time for the last day of Burma's New Year water festival. There are the customary airport formalities, including an inspection of honor guard, but otherwise the reception is marked by the prevailing holiday spirit. Later the Chinese visitor tours various pavilions where festivites are in progress. His welcome here is much friendlier than the one anticipated in India, which has been having serious border troubles with Red China for the past year. This is just a pleasant warm-up for Chou's real diplomatic test.
