PRINCESS ALEXANDRA'S PORTRAIT FOR "ORIANA"

Judy Cassab, the Australian artist, has completed a full length portrait of Princess Alexandra. The portrait, which was painted at Buckingham Palace, will hang in the main First Class entrance in "Oriana", the new Orient Line vessel. The portrait was commissioned by the Orient Line as it was Princess Alexandra who launched "Oriana" on November 3rd, 1959.

Judy Cassab, born in Vienna, has lived in Australia for the past 8 years. She is married with two sons. The daughter of artistic parents, she has been painting since she was 12 years old. Although so far probably better known for her abstract paintings, some of which were shown at her exhibition at the Crane Kalman Gallery last Autumn, she has earned a considerable reputation as a portrait painter, notably for her studies of Hugh Gaitskell, Peter Thorneycroft and model Barbara Goalen.
