

MOSS WINS MORE STERLING

16 cars got away in the Monaco Grand Prix. 100 laps of a 2-mile circuit through the Monte Carlo streets, the race of 1,000 corners. A testing race for cars and drivers, needing twenty gear changes every lap. The Swedish ace, Johachim Bonnier, driving a BRM, led in the early stage.

Stirling Moss (Lotus Climax) waited for the right moment before trying to go into the lead.

After nearly three hours Moss had a commanding lead. At an average of 67.5 miles an hour he won easily. So that's eight points in the bag towards this year's driving championship. It's a race worth winning, getting the Cup from Prince Rainier and a handshake from lovely Princess Grace.
