

50 YEARS OF EPSTEIN.

At the Leicester Galleries, an Epstein exhibition. With Lady Epstein, Countess Poullett, a bust of whom the great sculptor made in 1928. On show here are bronzes and drawings executed over a period of fifty years. Epstein died last year, after a working life in which he compelled the attention of nearly the whole world. Here, his bust of the Archbishop of Canterbury.
