Upon the request of the Congolese government, Ghanaian troops were sent to Stanleyville from Leopoldville, a distance of about 1,000 miles. The President and the Prime Minister of the Republic, Mr. Kasavubu and Mr. Lummumba were then on

a visit to the 5th Battalion of the Congolese army at Stanleyville. They went by ferry to the camp and on their way back, Mr. Lummumba addressed the natives (of Stanleyville) before receiving Major-General Alexander at the Governor's House at Stanleyville. Mr. Djin, G hana's Ambassador to the Congo accompanied the President and the Prime Minister on their visit.
