MOSS DRIVES AGAIN.

Stirling Moss was on the race track again - to test his nerve . At the wheel of a new two-and-a-half litre Lotus sports car he was at Silverstone only two days after he'd left hospital, and just five weeks after he fractured both legs and hurt his back, in that crash in Belgium. Many people thought he'd never race again. Deprived of his licence nowadays, Stirling was driven to Silverstone by his sister, Pat Moss (left) and also watched by his friend Helga Mayerhofer . As if he'd never had an accident in his life, Stirling set the sports car Silverstone lap record at more than 100 miles an hour.
