AFRICA'S NEW ARCHBISHOP.

The Archbishop of Canterbury arrived by air at Dodoma, during his visit to central Tanganyika. Dr. Fisher had a warm greeting by several clergy including Bishop Sturway, of the Central Diocese, and Bishop Omari of Ukaguru.

500 men and women, mostly connected with church work, attended a garden party in honour of Dr. Fisher.

94-year-old Angelina Reed and her missionary daughter, herself turned 70, were congratulated with many more, on their devotion to the church. But it was mainly to present and enthrone the new Archbishop of the Anglican Province of East Africa that Dr. Fisher was in Tanganyika. The Right Reverend Leonard Beecher, Bishop of Mombasa was chosen for this high office.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, now inducted the newest Archbishop, afterwards remarking that the Church had a high responsibility in helping Tanganyika in its spiritual and political development. When the service was over Dr. Fisher relaxed in the friendly manner which wins him affection whenever he goes overseas.
