PRACTICE PERIODS:

Practice takes place on Thursday and Friday, August 18th and 19th. Formula Junior racing cars will be on the track from 10.30 a.m. until noon and from 1.30 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. each day. Entries for the Tourist Trophy Race will practice between 3.00 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. on each day.

PROGRAMME:

B.A.R.C. International Formula Junior Championship: First Heat - 12 noon. Second Heat - 12.35 p.m. Both heats decided over 7 laps, first twelve in each heat to qualify for the final over 21 laps (50 miles) starting at 1.45 p.m.

25th R.A.C. Tourist Trophy Race - time and distance race of three hours duration starting at 3.00 p.m. and finishing at 6 p.m.

PRESS
INFORMATION:

Press information bulletins on both Practice days and Race Day itself will be available in the Press Room adjacent to the Race Control offices of the B.A.R.C. in the Paddock.

PRESS BADGES: Only Press Badges dated 20th August 1960 are valid for the meeting. These admit to the Press Stand, Competitors' Paddock Enclosure, and all other enclosures, but do NOT admit the holder to the track.

PHOTOGRAPHERS
& NEWSREEL
OPERATORS:

The B.A.R.C. Photographer Armlet dated 20th August 1960 takes the holder to all parts of the circuit but not into the Pit Road Area once racing has started. This ruling has been made by the race organisers in the interests of safety. Circuit Armlets dated as above and issued to certain newsreel camera crews admit to all parts of the track and the Pit Road Area during racing.

Both Photographer and Circuit armlets are issued on the strict understanding that the holder will comply with any instruction from officials on the track. Photographers and newsreel operators must keep clear of the actual road, must not in any way distract drivers, or interfere with the work of race officials.

Staging erected just past the Start Line and at Paddock Bend (the chicane) is primarily for the use of newsreel operators.

PRESS TELEPHONES: Telephones are installed in the Press Room in the Paddock. All telephone charges (excepting locals calls) must be reversed.

PRESS PROGRAMMES: One programme will be issued to each holder of a Press Badge or Photographer/Circuit Armlet on his signing the Press Book in the Press Room.
