The South African Government, to put it mildly, disliked him. And when his Anglican order, the Community of the Resurrection, recalled him to England, to had to leave a very sad flock behind. Their shepherd was being taken from them. It would be provocation to send him back to South Africa, but as a Bishop in Tanganyika Dr. Huddleston will be a powerful influence against racial hatred. Now as Africa is to see him again, the good wishes of those who pray that white and coloured men may live in harmony go with that great and enlightened Christian, Fr. Huddleston.
