Eight hours of international motor cycle road racing with World Champion riders in solo and sidecar events battling for over 1000 guineas in prize monies! This is the programme for one of the most outstanding motor sport meetings of the year - The Aintree Century - to be held over the famous Aintree Circuit on Saturday, September 24th.

Among the many famous stars who have already signed for this 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. meeting are T.T. riders Bob McIntyre and Mike Hailwood, who will dice against each other in another round of the no-holds-barred duel which they have fought all season.

For three-wheel fans, Pip Harris and partner will match their skill against Australian Sidecar Champion Bob Foster and the best of British and Continental twosomes, all eager to win the special "Daily Herald" Challenge Trophy.

CHAMPIONS FOR AINTREE

EIGHT-HOUR MEETING

The 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Aintree Century International Road Race Meeting on Saturday, September 24 will be one of the most outstanding motor sport events of the year with eight hours of non-stop motor-cycle thrills and spectacle.

Champion riders from all over the World will be taking part in the many solo and sidecar races. TT ace Bob McIntyre will face circuit rival Mike Hailwood in five of the events and Bob will cause something of a sensation at Aintree if, as he is hoping, he manages to bring over two Hondas - the Japanese wonder machines that have taken the motor-cycle world by storm - for his mounts in the Ultra Lightweight and Lightweight races.

Also signed for this important meeting is John Hartle, the 26-year-old from Chester, who this year took first place in the Junior TT and second place in the Senior TT on the Isle of Man. In the big 250 to 500 c.c. race of the day at Aintree it should be Hartle, McIntyre and Hailwood leading the field all the way in a tough and testing battle to a very close finish.

Among the other big names for The Century are solo riders Dan Shorey, J. Dunphy, Tom Charnley, Italy's Alberto Pagani, Peter Pawson from New Zealand, Australia's Trevor Pound and Tom Phillis and J. Grace from Gibraltar who in the Ultra Lightweight will be astride a 125 c.c. Bultaco.

For three-wheel fans, Pip Harris and partner will match their skill against World Sidecar Champion Helmut Fath, Switzerland's National Champion Claude Lambert and Florian Camathias, Sidecar Champion of Germany August Rohsiepe, Australian Sidecar Champion Bob Foster and more of the very best of British and overseas twosomes - including the indomitable Bill Boddice from Birmingham - all eager to win the special "Daily Herald" Trophy.
