Maying a dip in the briny no longer presents a major problem for disabled ex-servicemen, thanks to Mrs. Newton Driver. She put up £15,000 to have this special electric trolley built for the Services Club of which she is the founder-chairman. Designed by Mr. Pilcher, the trolley has just been installed at Bustington, Sussex.

Down the ramp, 50 yards long, 12 feet wide, the winch-driven trelley enters water deep enough for the men to swim away. Mrs. Newton Driver got the idea when she discovered that many of those who visit her elub had been keen swimmers before losing the use of their legs through either war wounds, accidents or police.

The trolley, believed to be the only one of its kind, could provide thousands of disabled people with a pleasure we all take for granted.
