Empire Pool, Wembley, 4th-8th October, 1960.

This is the second year that this great Show - probably the greatest indoor Horse Show in the world - is being staged at the Empire Pool, Wembley, and it's popularity is well illustrated by the fact that the last performance, on Saturday night, was sold out several weeks ago.

The Show will take its usual form, each performance starting and finishing with a jumping competition, with various show classes and displays in between.

Several alterations have been made to the jumping events. So keen are the show jumping world to take part in the classes for the Leading Jumper and Leading Junior Jumper of the Year that the qualifications for both these events have had to be considerably stiffened.

This year the Sunday Times Cup is being presented for a new competition which will be open to the 12 horses who have gained the greatest total of points in the British Show Jumping Association's Championships in various parts of the country, as well as all horses who have been placed first, or equal first, in any international jumping competition at an official international horse show, which means that it will become a championship of champions.

In the Showing classes, the class for cobs has been re-introduced.

The displays, etc., will provide as usual other highlights. They will include the ever-popular Musical Drive by teams of heavy horses, a parade of this year's horse personalities, in which horses from all walks of the horse world will take part, and the Pony Club Mounted Games Championship.

4th - 8th October, 1960.

All is now set at the Empire Pool, Wembley, for the opening of this great Show on Tuesday night, 4th October. A village consisting of several hundred caravans as well as 300 horse boxes, has been springing up behind the Pool in the last few days. The show jumpers, who will be taking part in this, the last show, of the season, will be arriving in their hundreds all over the weekend.

Captain Raimondo d'Inzeo from Italy, the World Show Jumping Champion, will be arriving at London Airport on 3rd October by Alitalia Flight No. 280, at 2.40 p.m. Senor Don Angel Peralta, the famous 'rejoneader' who will be giving displays of haute école at the Show, will be arriving at London Airport by Iberia Flight No. 424, at 2.45 p.m. He will be going direct to the Empire Pool so that he can take part in a dress rehearsal at 5.30 p.m. that evening, when all members of the Press will be welcome.

The last two nights of the Show are completely sold out and there are only a few tickets left for the Thursday evening.

The Press Office at the Empire Pool, (Wembley 1234), will open at 12 noon on Monday, 3rd October.

Although the international jumping championships are probably the most exciting features of the Show, many other highlights provide great variety for which the Show has such a reputation. One of these is the Parade of Horse Personalities, which this year covers nearly every walk of life in which the horse is found to-day.

Amongst the Stars will be:

CRUDWELL - that lion-hearted veteran steeplechaser, now retiring after winning no less than 50 races, more than any other horse since the war.

SALAD DAYS - with his owner Mr. Laurie Morgan of the Australian Olympic Team, the combination which won the individual Horse Trials Gold Medal at Rome earlier this month. This Trial is know as a supreme test of horse and rider and it is therefore only right that they should appear in this great Parade.

OLD DEAKS BUSTER - the Champion Donkey of the British Isles.

CONAR - a fine Arab stallion who was presented to Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth, The Queen Mother earlier this year by the Commander-in-Chief of the Jordanian Forces.

BABYLON - the ideal children's pony, who has taken part in all sections of Pony Club activities, besides travelling all over Europe with the British Army.

The Parade will be led as usual by Hannibal, the Drum Horse of the Household Cavalry, with four State Trumpeters.

For the fourth year, the final of the Mounted Games Championships for the Prince Philip Cup, will be held at the Show from 6th - 8th October. 169 Pony Club Branches entered teams for the first round of these Games and the following have won their way to Wembley:

- Eglinton
- Essex Hunt South
- High Peak Hunt North
- Blackmore Vale
- Meynell
- Banwen and District

This is the third year in which the Eglinton have got in the final. In 1958 they were 4th, last year they were second, so they should be favourites this year. The Banwen and District, composed entirely of miners children from South Wales, who train near the pit-head, and the Essex Hunt South are also coming for the second year running. The former being 3rd last year.
