A modern Noah's Ark is to sail down the Thames on Wednesday (October 12th) at 11 a.m. The occasion will be a reception to launch the special star gala performance of the Billy Smart Circus at Blackheath, S.E. London, on October 19th to aid the Variety Club of Great Britain, the children's charity organisation.

Noah's Ark in this instance will be the river boat Queen Elizabeth, and the point of departure will be the Festival Pier, Festival Hall.

The animals will embark two by two, and they will include elephants, lions, camels, chimpanzees, and llamas.

Among the passengers will be Burma, the lady elephant who sees life from many angles. Only last week, so it will be remembered, she created a slight problem when acting as a means of transport for Mr. Billy Smart and was parked beside a car meter in Grosvenor Square.

The 20th century Noah's Ark will feature a brass band to provide a musical background for the floating zoc.

Also aboard will be artistes of the Billy Smart Circus in their colourful costumes, and Big Top stars will number members of the Hungarian State Circus.

Many stars of screen, stage and television are attending the October 19th. performance, with some of them actually participating in ring acts and others sitting in the audience.
