ARLIIST CE DAY MARKED BY RIOTING IN ALBIERS I. - 35 mm. mereloped purchasts : UNDEVELOPED DUPENEGATIVE : 38 meters - 124 ft

Following official coremony at the War Memorial yn Armistice Day in Algiers, thousands of youngsters and some older persons - in all a crowd evaluated at 5.000 - stormed through the streets, battling police, wreaking immunex buses, smashing shop windows and sacking the U.S. Information Agency's cultural center. All this was directed against President de Gaulle's policy and his announcement of an Algerian Algeria. No moslems took part in the day's demonstrations which turned out into bloody risting. About a 100 people were reported wounded, 60 among police forces.

Police charged the crowd and threw tear gas after calling three times an elarm. Each time the crowd of youngsters run away and reformed in another street. Demonstrations and clashes with police forces went en from morning till 6 p.m. when everything went back to order.

Byen French Algeria groups made announcements denouncing the demonstrations which seem to have been launched by students, and have had no real organization.
