QUEEN MEETS UNEMPLOYED.

Holloway Employment Exchange, was honoured by the visit of the Queen. Minister of Labour, John Hare and the Mayor of Islington (Cllr. Mrs. Seeley) escorted Her Majesty. Mr. G.W. Reynolds, M.P. and Dr. Fletcher, M.P., two of Islington's Members were also introduced. First known as Islington Labour Exchange, Holloway Employment Exchange was one of the original 62 opened in Great Britain 50 years ago. The Queen had an official's eye view as the normal business proceeded. Then she chatted with some girls seeking employment while the Duke listened to the story of a coloured man.

Her Majesty saw how jobs are found for the unemployed. In their 50 years Labour Exchanges have found work for one hundred million people.
