## IT'S THE BIGGEST CHRISTMAS PUDDING IN THE WORLD: A STIRRING TIME FOR CHARLIE AND CLIFF

First taste of Christmas was savoured today (Thursday November 24) in London when British stars Charlie Drake and Cliff Richard went to Cadby Hall to stir the mixture for the world's biggest Christmas pudding.

The pudding - a massive 160-pounder which will provide portions for 1,000 people - is a goodwill Christmas gift from the dried fruit growers of Australia to the old people of the City of London.

Containing 120,000 currants, 30,000 sultanas and 8,000 raisins, the pudding will be presented to the Lord Mayor of London (Sir Bernard Waley Cohen) by the Australian High Commissioner in the UK (Sir Eric Harrison) at Australia House on December 8. Later in the month it will be handed over by Sir Bernard to the members of London's Three Score Club for old people in Gravel Lane, in the heart of the City.

The two stars - Cliff Richard took time off from the London
Palladium and Charlie Drake interrupted TV rehearsals in order to be
there - also stirred the mixture for 100 puddings to be sent to
cities and towns throughout the United Kingdom as far afield as
Penzance to Stornovay. Lord Mayors, Mayors, Lord Provosts and Provosts
will be passing on the puddings to local charities such as Darby and
Joan clubs, Evergreen clubs and UVS "Meals-on-Wheels" services.

The chief citizens of the 100 towns will also receive a smaller pudding for their own enjoyment at Christmas, and Charlie Drake and Cliff Richard labelled some of these for despatch by mail before they left Cadby Hall.

With the puddings to each civic head this year will go copies of a book - "Water Into Gold" - describing the rapid growth of the dried fruits industry of Australia during the past 60 years.

Altogether Australia's dried fruit grovers will give a helping of Christmas pudding to some 10,000 people in Britain next month.
