

TANGANYIKA INDEPENDENCE.

Jubilation was unbounded in Dar-es-Salaam. From the final session of the Constitutional Conference came Mr. Macleod (left), Mr. Julius Nyerere and the Governor, Sir Richard Turnbull, after the announcement that Tanganyika would have full internal self-government next May and full independence next December 28th. Chieftains and others met the Colonial Secretary at the Governor's Garden Party.

Hero of the hour was Chief-Minister Nyerere. He will be Prime Minister and preside over a Cabinet. His statesmanship has contributed to the untroubled progress from colonial status to independence. With members of his government Mr. Nyerere drove past the cheering crowds.

The enthusiasm was expressed in a variety of ways.
