60-70 ft approx. The Chief Minister of Tanganyika, Mr Julius Nyerere, clapping as the Secretary of State, Mr Iain Macleod, announces the date for Independence.

Reel 4. 1-40 Crowds dancing ^{and} in jovial mood awaiting to see Sec. of State, Governor, and Chief Minister, after closing session of Constitutional Conference.

41-80 Sec. of State and Chief Minister being garlanded on steps of Karamjee Hall after Conference, and waving to crowd.

81-120 Chief Minister chaired by people and carried to Land Rover for his triumphant drive through the town.

121-140 General view, crowd.
