After an early morning service in Albert Square, several hundred Sunday-school children marched first to the Cathedral and then back to their perishes. Sunday school attendance isn't the more or less compulsory matter that it was in the early years of the 19th century, when the first Procession of Whitness took place, so it's much to the credit of Manchester that in this day and age so many children enjoyed taking part.
