MAKE YOUR OWN DINGHY

Do you want to build your own boat in a single morning and go afloat in it that afternoon? Polyester Reains of a new kind make that programme possible, for the first time. To beat the clock, in this demonstration, glass fibre was fitted into the mould, much as in the ordinary method, which took about a week to make a finished boat. The new-type reain is the secret of the big time saving; it quickly sets the glass fibre, hard and unshrinkable, without any baking in an oven - necessary hitherto. That being all for the time being, they knocked off for lumeh, which gave the dinghy time to set. It was then taken from the mould and finished off. They counted the minutes till they could put her on the water.

To escape overgrowded roads, more and more people are becoming week-end sailors. The new boat was the latest recruit. Thanks to do-it-yourself dinghies, yachting in a modest way is within everybody's reach.
