SPRING HORSE DRIVE

HORSES DRIVEN 66 MILES FROM WINTERING GROUNDS TO BANFF NATIONAL PARK FOR PARK WARDEN WORK

Alberta, May, 1961.

Every spring, horses which have spent the winter in their wintering grounds at the Canadian Government Yaha Tinda Ranch in Alberta are rounded up and driven through some of Canada's most scenic countryside with fascinating names to Banff National Park for use by the Park Wardens in patrolling their districts, to preserve the beautiful natural playgrounds in Banff National Park - one of the many in a chain stretching across Canada. The Park Wardens patrol the boundries of the Park which covers over 2,500 square miles, ensuring that the wild life is protected, being helpful to tourists, checking fishing licenses, checking the riding trails, watching for fire hazards, and generally maintaining the services of the Park.

Our story covers the round up of the horses, separating those to be taken in from the grazing land for shoeing, and the actual making of the horseshoes at the forge. When weather conditions permit due to the late spring this year, the Park Wardens arrive at Yaha Tinda to start the 66 mile drive to Banff.

The horses are driven from Yaha Tinda, past Bighorn Falls, through Bighorn Creek Canyon to Scotch Camp where a lunch stop is made - the horses are fed and the trail cook produces delicious steaks for the sustenance of the Wardens. Following a well-deserved rest, the trek is on again - over Snow Pass, 8000', the highest point on the trip; through streams and the swift Panther River; over the Cuthead; through Cascade Valley and down a little fire road in this valley; to a paved road; across the C.P.R. railway tracks; and through the gate at the Banff National Park. The final sequences are of the horses in the Banff corral - the end of the line with mountains in the background - all ready for the beginning of a new season's work.
