

FARMERS PROBLEM

Following a week's unrest in Brittany where farmers blocked roads, invested cities and surrounded Prefectures, the climax of demonstrations came in MORLAIX (Brittany) when two of the Farmers' Union Leaders who had been imprisoned ten days ago went on trial.

They had been charged with breaking in the Morlaix Prefecture, disrupting communications and .. sitting in the Prefect's chair... The town of MORLAIX, usually so quiet, was entirely invested by police forces and all traffic banned inside the city. However, crowds of farmers from the surrounding villages and cities all over Brittany came to Morlaix and held a noisy meeting on the big Market Square during the Trial. At the end of the trial the two Leaders, Gourvenec, and Leon were released, and born on their comrade's shoulders amid cheers across the crowd of demonstrators.

Meanwhile the farmers' problem situation had been spreading Mr. Jeanneney (throughout numerous other regions of France, and yesterday in PAU, (south West Minister of ~~XX~~(of France) a Government member, ~~Mr. ROBERT~~ saw his Industry. (car stopped by demonstrators, and he discussed matters directly with the assembled farmers.

The angry farmers had surrounded the PAU casino where Mr. Jeanneney was having ~~lunch~~ lunch with other personalities, and were shouting after Government measures. The Minister decided to go out through a side-door to reach his special train, but was surrounded by demonstrators and manhandled. He finally succeeded in reaching through the blockade to his train... but it was a close shave...

Farmers all over France are impatient before long promised reforms which - they feel- have not been carried on, and seeing that the hard way has won new measures for Breton farmers, they are now all decided to make their own demands loudly known and try their chance at having them heard by the Government through violence if necessary.
