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WARRIORS SEE STEEL PLANT.

The Rhodesian Iron and Steel Company invited some old experts
to look over the new plant at Redcliff. In the days when
Rhodesia was conquered they made the agasegais for Lobengulas
warriers, little dreaming they'd live to see this gigantic steelworks
arise on the old battlegrounds. It's part of the Company's
10 million po und expansion programme, to give the Federation all
the steel it requires.

Vanjanja tribesmen still make iron spears by methods used for at least 300 years in these parts. Goatskin bellows blow charcoal to white-heat in little furnaces. The village smithy is just as primitive. Now there's no war they make musical instruments for the dancing. Half a dried gourd, fitted with 20 metal keys.

In the Federation, ancient and new still rub shoulders.
