

Subject: FURTHER PRESS RELEASE ON FINCHLEY'S CARNIVAL & FETE SATURDAY JULY 15th
IN SUPPORT OF FINCHLEY'S CANCER WEEK, JULY 11th-18th.

(1) Final arrangements have now been made for the gigantic carnival procession and Fete which is taking place on Saturday July 15th at the Victoria Recreation Ground, Ballards Lane, N. 30.

(2) CARNIVAL PROCESSION. This procession will consist of some 35-40 decorated floats made up of local and nationally known firms. The procession will commence at 1.30 p.m. and will start from the junction of Bishops Avenue with the High Road N. 2. proceeding northwards along the High Road to as far as Christchurch Avenue. It will turn left at Christchurch Avenue and left again at the junction of Christchurch Avenue and Ballards Lane. It will proceed southwards along Ballards Lane past the North West entrance of Victoria Recreation Ground and will turn left into Long Lane following the perimeter of the Recreation Ground and will disperse into Park Road and the adjacent turnings. The length of the procession will be approximately 1/3 mile in length.

(3) The procession will be headed by the pipe and drum band of the 57th (MIDDX) General Hospital R.A.M.C. T.A. by kind permission of Lt. Col. Dalliwell, this will be followed by a colour party, the escort provided by the Hornsey Branch of the Army Cadet Force. His Worship the Mayor of Finchley, Councillor F. Gibson J.P. (HON. PRESIDENT OF THE FINCHLEY COMMITTEE BRITISH EMPIRE CANCER CAMPAIGN) and the Lady Mayoress will follow in an open car. The detachment of the 5th Company 10th Battalion Parachute Regiment T.A. will ^{bring} ~~precede~~ up the rear of this first section of the procession. Amongst the very many decorated floats will be the floral decorated float of the Southend Corporation together with Carnival and Beauty Queens.

(4) On its arrival at Victoria Recreation Ground, the Mayor, colour party, and leading band will enter onto our Central Display Arena. The Mayor will then dismiss the party and view the remainder of the afternoons entertainment.
