

TRUCK FOR LAND AND SEA

Those six wheels will take it anywhere on land; and the well named Stalwart - the Alvis cross-country load-carrier, has another remarkable string to its bow - it can swim. More about that in a minute. Independent springing all round irons out the bumps.

Now see it cool down. After all, that effort, a pleasant swim. The 220 brake horse power engine takes in water at the front, then forces it out astern at high pressure, to give a speed of five knots.

Stalwart is mainly intended for military use, also its makers believe it has great commercial possibilities. Under its own power all the way, it is shortly making a trip to Germany.
