COPY OF MEMO FROM MR. DAVID JONES TO MR. CUMMINS

2nd August, 1961.

Dear Tommy,

Following our conversation yesterday, I am pleased to give you some details of the Tenpin Bowling Match which is to take place at the new Leytonstone Bowl on Saturday, August 26th.

It will be the first ever inter-county match between Warwick and Essex. It will also be the first game ever played at Leytonstone, the official civic opening of which is arranged for 8.00 pm. on the following Tuesday, August 29th.

I will, of course, advise you of the time of the Saturday match.

I have, in the meantime, come to an arrangement with the Sportsview Programme of the B.B.C. to provide them with a film covering the last 3½ to 4 minutes of the county match, which I am hopeful you will 'shoot' for me. The scheme is to make a silent film and add commentary after the film is cut.

The B.B.C. have laid down a condition that the film must be in their hands on Tuesday, August 29th, and I am anxious to please them, since coverage of our Centre in this programme is of the utmost importance.

Our Executive in Charge of Bowling, Mr. David Goddard, will be at the Centre on Saturday, August 26th and of course will do everything in his power to help you with facilities and expert guidance.

I should be glad to have your co-operation on this project, which I consider to be very valuable indeed.

It is perfectly in order to charge ABC the sum of £50 for providing a four minute film on the finale of the interCounty Tempin Bowling Match which is to be played between Essex and Warwick at the Leytonstone Bowl on Saturday August 25th, 1961.

The film will require a commentary, and David Goddard our Executive in Charge of Bowling, and an expert on the game, will be available for providing expert description.

Thank you for your assistance.

Many thanks indeed for your letter of the 9th sanctioning the expenditure of £50 for providing a four minute film of the inter-county Tempin Bowling match at Leytonstone on August 25th.

Your last paragraph worries me considerably as we shall have no time here for recording a commentary. I understood from you in your previous letter that all we were required to do was to supply the B.B.C. by Tuesday morning, August 29th, with a black and white cut story of 3½ to 4 minutes of our coverage in silent form, and they, the B.B.C., would record a commentary.

I automatically assumed that this could be very easily done on tape at their studios.

When I quoted the price of £50 this merely covered our negative print costs plus lighting.

Please ascertain if the B.B.C. could undertake this work under the guidance of David Goddard. It would be much easier.
