

TINA WEDS

Outside a fashionable Greek Orthodox church in Paris - the Marquess of Blandford, son of the Duke of Marlborough. He and a host of photographers are awaiting his bride, Tina Livanos, arriving for one of the most talked-about weddings of the year.
