Shot of Panjim harbour which was under the Portugese possession for 450 years. Indian Navy ships are standing.

Long and medium shot of Indian fisherman's boat which was shot by the Portugese and which led to the advance of Indian army. The half sunken boat is seen in the frame.

Shots of Indian naval ratings coming in towards the port and getting down from the boat.

General shot of Goa port with Indian ~~navy~~ ships INS MYSORE and INS DELHI standing in the harbour.

Shot of the captured arms and ammunition and supply boxes near the port.

Shot of ~~Vasco~~ Vasco-di-gama (a town in Goa) This town is named after the famous portugese explorer Vasco-di-gama who had first come to this portugese territory. Shots of the street, people moving in freely.

Shot of PANJIM (the capitol of Goa) town. Shot of former Portugese Governer General's residence on which the Indian flag was flying.

Shot of Indian army going in army trucks. Shot of the street with local people walking without any fear.

Shot of the public procession in Panjim in which people carried the Indian tricolour flag and raised the slogan 'Bharat Mata ki Jay ' (Long live mother India.)

After 450 years of Portugese occupation , Major General CANDETH of Indian Army has been named as the first Military Governer of Goa. Shots of first Press Conference which was attended by Maj. Gen. Candeth and other high officials who would be running the administration in the Portugese territory.

Shot of Military Governer (Maj. Gen. Candeth) coming out after Press Conference and entering his office.

Shot of the Portugese Governer General's residence in Panjim this has now been converted for the use of the Indian Military Governer. Shot of changing of Guards at the Pa;ace compound.

Various shots of Army personnel on duty.

Shots made at the Portugese Prisoner's Camp where 180 captive officer and over 4,000 soldiers are now under detention. At one time this location was used as Army Mess but now it is a Prisoner's camp. Shot of lined up prisoners. Lt. Colnel Sucha Singh of Indian Army giving orders to Major Toredo (of Portugese Army) to obey the orders of the Indian Army and to honour the rules prescribed for the prisoners of War. After taking the new orders Major Toredo saluting the Indian Lt. Colnel and then translating the same in the Portugese language for the benefit of others.
