

The Automatic Tent!

The most exciting news for the motorist for a long time is the "Tent-O-Matic". This is a new type of frame tent for the family which consists of a luggage rack which almost automatically builds itself into a full size tent.

Just attach the luggage rack to the roof of any car, (which can also be used for normal load carrying) with the quick action clips, drive on to the selected site, press a few buttons and the rack automatically lengthens, forming the roof of the tent frame, clip on the telescopic legs, unroll the canvas, then drive away the car, and there in a matter of a few minutes you have a full size tent over 6 ft. high, sleeping four adults in an inner tent which has a sewn-in ground sheet. There is also extra living space.

The inner tent slides away to provide even more living space during the day.

Erection of tent is so simple that it requires one person only and there is no lifting.

The "Tent-O-Matic" is made by ICM (Manufacturers)Ltd., 221-225, Grove Hall Court, Hall Road, N.W.8., and will shortly be available at most retailers.

ROYAL MARINE CLIMBERS TO DEMONSTRATE AT OLYMPIA ark for Capl Hamilton Weikle Visitors to this year's Camping and Outdoor Life Exhibition who want to learn how to climb safely will get tips from Royal Marine cliff assault specialists on a specially-constructed cliff face when the exhibition opens at the Empire Hall, Olympia, on Friday 5th January.

The cliff face has been designed and pre-fabricated and taken to the exhibition in sections. When selected members of the public are invited to try their skill during the exhibition they will find that the Royal Marine specialists have incorporated as many hazards as possible in "London's Little Cliff-face" to produce a difficult climb.

Among the Royal Marine instructors highlighting the important points of safe and successful climbing will be Lieutenant V.N. Stevenson, R.M., and Corporal Reverley Todd, who 12 months ago led a successful assault on

the hitherto unclimbed West Peak of the 9,565 ft. Mount Paget in the Antarotic.

Other Royal Marine exhibits at the show include the winning cance from this year's Devizes-Westminster race, which the Royal Marines won in a new record time - the sixth win by a Royal Marine crew in the past seven years.
