

PARIS IN MOURNING.

A funeral procession, bigger than any in modern times, made its way to the Pere Lachaise Cemetery. Half a million people paid their impressive tribute to the eight victims of the rioting, in the Place de la Bastille, five days previously. In this way all sections of Left Wing Paris, including Catholics, Socialists and Communists, expressed their anger over the bomb outrages of the O.A.S., the Organization of the Secret Army.

The procession was orderly, but it left the Government in no doubt that the nation will not tolerate much longer the violence, of the O.A.S. If the lawless body is not suppressed, De Gaulle's government may be over-thrown.
