## PARIS IN MOURNING.

A funeral procession, bigger than any in modern times, made its way to the Pere Lachaise Cemetry. Half a million people paid their impressive tribute to the eight victims of the ricting, in the Palee de la Bastille, five days previously. In this way all sections of Left Wing Paris, including Cathelics, Socialists and Communists, expressed their anger over the bomb outrages of the O.A.S., the Organisation of the Secret Army.

The procession was orderly, but it left the Government in no doubt that the nation will not tolerate much longer the violence, of the 0.A.S. If the lawless body is not surpressed, De Gaulle's government may be over-thrown.
