Kingdom and Eire.

am hoping that this is a mistake, because as you know there are
only two newsreel companies operating, British Movietonews and
ourselves, and we have always paid you £10. 0. 0. - unfortunately
unlike so many other products we do not get extra money for our
newsreels - even in these expensive days of 1962.
