JOUHAUD SENTENCED TO DEATH

35 mm. developed dupenegative: 13 meters - 43 ft

Ex-General Edmond Jouhaud was sentenced to death friday night by a court of three generals, a vice-admiral and five civilians for having plotted against the state, been a leader in the Secret Army Organization (OAS) and helped organize the 1961 generals' insurrection.

The 57-year-old OAS leader stood to hear his sentence and accepted it without flinching. The sentence came after a three-day trial. A long procession of witnesses testified that Jouhaud had acted as he did because he is a native of Algeria and a soldier. Other witnesses described the bloody terrorism of the OAS in Oran where he headed the guerilla organization.

In his summation on the last day of the trial, Prosecutor, Mr. Raphael listed the crimes of the OAS in the Oran region ...
