U.S. RESUMES BOMB TESTS

Christmas Island, where we tested our first H-Benb, is now the scene of the resumed American nuclear bomb tests in the atmosphere, fired from different types of rockets.

From nuclear powered submarines polaris missiles will be fired and their warheads tried out. This is the weapon in which America puts most faith. Hundreds of miles from enemy costs the Polaris can be fired at the target.

America considers nuclear tests to be necessary, as Khruschev will not allow inspection inside Russia. Washington politicians endorse President Kennedy's policy. On the subject, hear Senator Henry Jackson:-
