TORNADO WRECKS 300 HOMES.

Heartbreaking devastation lies in the wake of the tornado that struck Waterbury, Connecticut. It cut a path three miles long, 200 yards wide. Though lasting no more than a minute it destroyed several factories and 300 houses. Damage topped a million dollars. National Guards were brought in to prevent looting.

At such times it's not easy to look for a bright side: yet remembering the high death toll of similar tornadoes, Waterbury congratulates itself that here only one person was killed, nine injured. It happened in the afternoon, when few people were at home.
