## TORNADO WRECKS 300HOMES.

Hearthreaking devastation lies in the wake of the tornado that struck Waterbury, Connecticut. It cut a path three miles long, 200 yards wide. Though lasting no more than a minute it destroyed several factories and 300 houses. Damage topped a million dollars. National Guards were brought in to prevent locting.
