Camberwell gave a heartfelt welcome to King Hussein of Jordan. The Monarch was making an informal visit with Her Royal Highness Princess Muna, his English-born wife, to lay the foundation stone of St. Giles Youth Club. Before the marriage, the Princess was Miss Toni Gardner.

King Hussein accepted this engagement out of friendship for the Vicar of St. Giles, the Rev. John Nicholls, whom he met in Palestine during the World War. Last year the Vicar took 40 boys to Hussein's Youth Camp in Jordan.

The Club will be built in the Vicarage Garden. It will cost about £30,000, and will be affiliated to the London Federation of Boys' Clubs. It got off to a royal and friendly start.
