COMMISSIONING OF NO. 801 BUCCANEER SQUADRON

FLEET AIR ARM

The Royal Navy's first operational squadron of Buccaneer strike aircraft will commission for service at the Royal Naval Air Station, Lossiemouth, Morayshire, on Tuesday 17th July.

There will be an opportunity for Press representatives to see a flying demonstration by these aircraft on Monday 16th July (air-to-air photographic facilities will be provided) and to stay over until the next day to witness the commissioning ceremony. They will also be able to tour the Air Station, which is the Royal Navy's largest and busiest and the parent airfield for all operational and training strike squadrons.

A limited number of places will be provided in Naval transport aircraft leaving Northolt on Monday morning for Lossiemouth and returning to Northolt on Tuesday evening. → O.K.

Application for passes, stating whether air transport from Northolt is required, should be made to the Department of Chief of Naval Information, Admiralty, S.W.1 (Telephone Whitehall 9000, Ext. 1125) not later than noon on Wednesday 11th July.
