When running in pairs the rider of the Horse bearing the lesser or top number on the Telegraph Board carries a Red Band across the shoulder. The rider of the Horse bearing the greater or bottom number wears a White Band. The ringing of a gong denotes that the Competitor is eliminated.

The times at which the Jumping Competitions are programmed to take place are subject to alteration at the discretion of the Committee.

Time may be used at the discretion of the Judges to decide the result of any Competition (except Competitions over banks) after the first round.

At various points in the Show Grounds "The Public Address System" (installed by Standard Telephones and Cables, Ltd.) will be used to give further official information to visitors.
