1. M.S. of Churchill seated in an open car driving through the crowded streets of Lancashire, he is wearing a donkey jacket and peaked cap. 18
2. M.S. pan with Churchill with local dignitaries as he walks through a bombed area, he signs the visitors book on a table amidst the ruins, camera pans away to ruined homes. 56
3. M.S. to c.u. of Churchill as he walks towards the camera, acknowledging the cheers from the surrounding crowds. 66
4. C.U. of Churchill smoking a cigar with a damaged building in the background. 80

ADVANCE ON KEREN

-Paramount & War Office

1. Various shots of British and Indian troops advancing up a steep rough hillside with the aid of mules, shells are exploding nearby fired by the Italian artillery. 60
2. M.S. of two Italian prisoners as they are brought down the hill. 80
3. Panning shots from one group of prisoners to another. 96
4. Ground to air m.s. of a British biplane dropping supplies. 104
5. Various c.us. of British troops resting in their trenches at the top of a hill, camera pans out to give a g.v. of the surrounding hills in the direction of Keren. 131

(The battle of Cape Matapan took place on Sunday 30th. March 1941, the Italian cruiser Fiume was sunk along with the cruisers Pola and Zara, the British suffered no damage or casualties.)

1. Various shots of Italian prisoners, captured at Cape Matapan, in the prison compounds in the North African Desert. 19
2. L.S. of H.M.S. Warspite. 22
3. L.S. of an aircraft carrier in the harbour at Alexandria. 27
4. C.U.s. of fifteen inch shells as they are loaded aboard H.M.S. Warspite. 50
5. C.U. of the barrel of one of the fifteen inch guns, pan down the barrel to the main part of the gun. 57
6. M.S. to c.u. of Admiral Sir Andrew Cunningham, on the deck of Warspite. 70
