- 1. Various shots of French light and medium field guns, heavy entrenched artillery and railway guns firing, good montage of a large and heavy artillery barrage being laid, French troops visible in almost every shot and all guns obviously 1939 vintage 60
- 2. Various shots of French general christening four new very heavy railway guns with champagne 41

SCUTTLED BY ORDER OF HITLER - ~~SELIGMANN~~

- 1. G.V. american cruiser the Tuscaloosa at sea in heavy seas 24
 - 2. Various shots of the crew and passengers on board the German liner Columbus taking to the lifeboats prior to the ship being scuttled (poor quality 16mm blow up) 55
 - G.V. American and British cruiser ploughing through heavy seas 11
 - G.V. from a lifeboat as it pulls away from the side of the Columbus, which starts to burn as the lifeboat reaches a unsafe distance. (poor quality 16mm blow up) 22
 - 5. G.Vs from sea and air of the Graf Spee burning after being scuttled off Montevideo, Uruguay (LIB SHOTS) 32
 - 6. L.S. of the Columbus burning from bow to stern, taken from the leading lifeboat as it continues to move away from the liner. (poor quality 16mm blow up)
