"GONE WITH THE WIND" PREMIERE

Hollywood comes on wings of the wind to Atlanta, Georgia. For the event all Dixey, indeed all America has been waiting for, a world premiere of the film "Gone with the Wind" in which the chief part of Scarlet O'Hara is played by Britain's own Vivien Leigh and here she is. Producer David O. Selznick is here for the first night of his career and Miss Leigh to receive America's applause for a difficult role. Olivier de Havilland is in the cavalcade of stars which includes Carol Lombard and her husband Clark Gable who plays Rett Butler in the celebrated story of the Civil War. All Atlanta swarms the streets with most of the City's 300 thousand watching the parade of the stars. Along famous Beach Tree Street the motorcade moves through cheering crowds.
