When they move to a new place they build their own log cabin. Its almost a scene in the wild west. They have a snappy idea for filling ~~the~~ in the cracks between the logs... with dried moss. But the most surprising thing about them is that they actually enjoy our weather.

They're used to working in sub zero temperatures and snow several feet deep.... For them our climate is as good as a trip to the Riviera.
