ANZAC DAY IN AUSTRALIA

1. V.S. of troops, veterans and police marching through the crowd lined streets of Sydney in celebration of Anzac Day 44
 2. High angle g.v. packed stadium with the crowd singing and a flag draped daid in the stadium from where the singing is led 25

 2. V.S. shots from library of German parachutists dropping on manoeuvres 28

 4. M.S. men queuing up to sign on for the Defence Volunteer Corps 20
 5. C.U. application form for the corps 5
