EVACUATION OF THE B.E.F.

- Dunkirk 1-7. ✓ 1. G.V. destroyer at sea at night with aldis lamp flashing out signal 8
- A/F. Naval - Brit. ✓ 2. V.S. of destroyers and rescue ships - including peacetime pleasure paddle boat- at sea coming and going towards Dunkirk 55
- Signals Wireless ✓ 3. V.S. excellent shots taken from one of the rescue ships just off Dunkirk, showing ships lying offshore as rowing boats move back and forth between ships and the beaches, men of the BEF climbing aboard the rescue ships and also coming out from the beaches through the sea towards the rescue ships. Also l.s.s. of the huge smoke clouds behind the beaches and of the beaches in f.g. dotted with men awaiting rescue. L.S. german aircraft over the beach with guns from the ships firing up at them 112
- A/F. Army. Brit. Soldiers 1-7. ✓ 4. V.S. of British and French soldiers landing from rescue ships at South Coast english harbours - good shots inc. c.us. 97
- Navy. France 1-7. ✓ 5. V.S. of the rescued soldiers in a reception hall near the harbour putting on clean clothes 26

- Destroyers 1-2. ✓ 7. E.V. from ship of the scene on the beaches at Dunkirk, showing the huge smoke clouds behind the beaches and the men of the BEF coming out from the shore towards the rescue ships 20
