DUKE AND DUCHESS OF WINDSOR AT BERMUDA.

From the American Liner EXCALIBUR to the steps of the Royal Bermuda Yacht Club landing, come the Duke and Duchess of Windsor on a visit to Government House, Hamilton. The Duke is on his way to take up his post as Governor and Commander in Chief of the Bahamas.

At the end of a Conference held in the sitting room of Government House, the Duke and Duchess take a stroll in the magnificent grounds and are interviewed by a large body of newspaper men. Looking remarkably well the Duke and Duchess assured questioners of their plan to visit the United States in the not-so-far distant future.

The Bahamas' new Governor (although widely travelled) has not previously visited the Islands he is to Govern.
